1. Introduction

2. Data Controller

3. Personal Data Collection

We do not collect personal data such as names, email addresses, or payment information. We may collect technical and usage data automatically, including:

- IP address (anonymised where possible)
- Browser type and version
- Device type
- Pages visited
- Date and time of visits

4. Analytics

We use website analytics tools (such as Google Analytics or similar) to understand how visitors use our website and to improve its performance.

Analytics data is:

- Collected in aggregated form
- Used only for statistical and performance purposes
- Not used to identify individual users

You may disable cookies via your browser settings.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

Under GDPR, we process data based on:

- Legitimate interest (website performance, security, and analytics)
- Consent, where required by law (for cookies and analytics)

6. Cookies

Our website uses cookies to:

- Enable essential website functionality
- Analyze website traffic

You can control or delete cookies through your browser settings at any time.

7. Data Sharing

We do not sell or rent personal data.

Data may be shared only with:

- Analytics service providers
- Authorities, if required by law

All third parties are required to comply with GDPR.

8. Data Retention

Analytics data is stored only for as long as necessary to fulfill its purpose or as required by applicable law.

9. Your Rights Under GDPR

As an EU resident, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Request correction or deletion
- Object to or restrict processing
- Lodge a complaint with the Finnish Data Protection Authority

10. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect data against unauthorised access, alteration, or loss.
