

PRIVACY POLICY RESTAURANT NOLLA

1. Introduction

Restaurant Nolla ("we", "us", or "our") operates the website www.restaurantnolla.com. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect personal data in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). By using our website, you agree to the practices described in this policy.

2. Data Controller

The Data Controller is Restaurant Nolla, Finland. For privacy-related questions, you may contact us via the contact details provided on our website.

3. Personal Data Collection

We may collect the following data:

- IP address (anonymised where possible)
- Browser type and version
- Device type
- Pages visited
- Date and time of visits
- Email addresses: Collected via our booking partner, DinnerBooking.com, when you provide consent for marketing communications.

4. Analytics and Advertising

We use website analytics tools (such as Google Analytics or similar) to understand how visitors use our website and to improve its performance.

Analytics data is collected in aggregated form and used for statistical purposes.

- Customer Match: We may use hashed email addresses to reach you with relevant advertisements via Google Ads.
- Remarketing: We use cookies to serve targeted ads based on your previous interaction with our website.

You may disable cookies via your browser settings.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

Under GDPR, we process data based on:

- Legitimate interest (website performance, security, and analytics).
- Consent, where required by law (for cookies, analytics, and personalized marketing/advertising).

6. Cookies

Our website uses cookies to:

- Enable essential website functionality.
- Analyze website traffic.
- Personalized Advertising: To tailor advertisements to your interests and measure campaign performance.

You can control or delete cookies through your browser settings at any time.

7. Data Sharing

We do not sell or rent personal data. Data may be shared only with:

- Analytics service providers.
- Advertising Partners: Specifically Google, for the purpose of matching our customer lists with their advertising profiles.
- Authorities, if required by law.

All third parties are required to comply with GDPR.

8. Data Retention

Analytics and marketing data is stored only for as long as necessary to fulfill its purpose or as required by applicable law.

9. Your Rights Under GDPR

As an EU resident, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data.
- Request correction or deletion.
- Object to or restrict processing (including opting out of marketing lists).
- Lodge a complaint with the Finnish Data Protection Authority.

10. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect data against unauthorised access, alteration, or loss. This includes hashing email addresses before uploading them to advertising platforms.
